A RESOLUTION

To recognize Tuesday, May 3, 2011, as Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors follow rules of professional conduct in order to safeguard life, health, and property and promote the public welfare; and

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors establish and maintain a high standard of integrity in the performance of their professional duties; and

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors are committed to maintaining the highest levels of professional quality and to keeping abreast of the most advanced technology in their field, including global positioning, mapping, and spatial referencing, as they seek to ensure the provision of state-of-the-art surveying services to the citizens of Louisiana; and
