A RESOLUTION

To commend the Lutchter High School girls' powerlifting team for winning its tenth consecutive Division III state title.

WHEREAS, the achievements of the athletes who comprise the Lutchter High School girls' powerlifting team are notable and worthy of recognition, and for the tenth straight year, these young women have brought great pride to their school and community with their winning ways.
