A RESOLUTION

To recognize the Turquoise Council of Americans and Eurasians on the occasion of the Turkic-Louisianian Legislative reception.

WHEREAS, the Turquoise Council of Americans and Eurasians is an independent umbrella organization dedicated to promoting interaction and goodwill between people of Turkic and Eurasian heritage and other people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Turkey has the sixteenth largest economy in the world and has enjoyed a strong, vibrant, and mutually beneficial economic relationship with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the council participates in a variety of outreach programs and events including the annual Congressional Friendship Dinner in Washington, DC, sister city pacts between American and Turkish cities, and town hall meetings; and
