RECORDS/RECORDATION: Requests the House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to study redacting social security numbers from recorded documents

1	A STUDY REQUEST
2	To the House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to study the redaction of social
3	security numbers from recorded documents and to report its findings to the House
4	of Representatives prior to the convening of the 2011 Regular Session of the
5	Legislature.
6	WHEREAS, obtaining the social security number of a person is a key component
7	used in identity theft; and
8	WHEREAS, over the past several years, legislation requiring identifying information
9	on recorded documents has been limited to requiring only the last four digits of the social
10	security number in order to impede the commission of identity theft; and
11	WHEREAS, prior to limiting social security numbers to the last four digits,
12	Louisiana law required the inclusion of the entire social security number on certain recorded
13	documents, and these documents are still part of the public records existing throughout the
14	various parishes of this state; and
15	WHEREAS, it would assist in the protection against identity theft if recorded
16	documents were redacted in such a way as to remove all but the last four digits of the social
17	security number.
18	THEREFORE, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana requests
19	the House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to study the redaction of social security
20	numbers from recorded documents and to report its findings to the House of Representatives
21	prior to the convening of the 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature.
