SENATE BILL NO. 101

BY SENATOR GUILLORY

CHARITABLE GAMING. Increases the number of days that games of chance may be conducted. (8/1/12)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 4:714(A), relative to charitable gaming; to increase the number
3 of days a licensee may hold, operate, or conduct any game of chance within a
4 calendar month; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 4:714(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §714. Restrictions; requirements; transfers; prohibitions

8 A. No licensee shall hold, operate, or conduct any game of chance under this
9 Chapter more often than on ~~fifteen~~ **twenty** days in any one calendar month.

11 Section 2. Nothing in this Act shall permit the expansion of video bingo in any
12 parish in the state of Louisiana.

DIGEST

Guillory (SB 101)

Present law limits to 15 days within a calendar month that a licensee may hold, operate, or conduct any game of chance.

Proposed law increases the number of days within a calendar month from 15 to 20 that a licensee may hold, operate, or conduct any game of chance.

Specifically state that nothing in proposed law shall permit expansion in video bingo in any parish.

Effective August 1, 2012.

(Amends R.S. 4:714(A))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill.

1. Specifically states that nothing be construed to authorize expression of video bingo.
