6	Section 1. R.S. 26:91(A)(2) and 287(A)(1)(a) are hereby amended and reenacted to

8	§91. Additional causes for suspension or revocation of permits; fines
9	A. In addition to any other causes enumerated in this Chapter, the
10	commissioner may suspend or revoke any permit for any one of the following
11	causes:

13	(2) If there was any misstatement or suppression of fact in the application
14	for the permit or if applicant, licensee, or any other person required to meet the
15	qualifications of an applicant, with the intent to misstate or suppress, fails to
16	provide information and documentation, known of at the time of application or
17	learned of at any time after the issuance of a permit, that may reveal any fact
18	material to a suitability determination or knowingly supplies information,
19	during the initial application or following the issuance of a permit, which is
20	untrue or misleading as to a material fact pertaining to the provisions of R.S.
