AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 33:2541.1(B)(1)(c), relative to the St. Martinville police department; to provide relative to the deputy chief of police; to provide relative to the classification of the position; to provide relative to selection, appointment, supervision, and discharge of the deputy chief of police; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:2541.1(B)(1)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§2541.1. Deputy chief of police; competitive appointment

* * *

B.(1) * * *

(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, in the city of St. Martinville, the qualifications for the position of deputy chief of police shall be not less than five years of full-time law enforcement experience. **In addition, the position of deputy chief of police shall be in the unclassified police**
