6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 40:1299.41(L) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1299.41. Definitions and general applications
9	* * *
10	L. Any cause of action for the unintentional acts or omissions arising
11	from resuscitating a patient who has a declaration concerning life-sustaining
12	procedures executed pursuant to R.S. 40:1299.58.1 et seq., a Louisiana
13	Physician Order for Scope of Treatment executed pursuant to R.S. 40:1299.64.1
14	et seq., or a do not resuscitate order issued by a physician licensed in this state
15	shall be governed by the provisions of this Part.
16	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be given prospective application only and
17	shall not affect any action pending or claim arising prior to the effective date of this Act.
18	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
19	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
20	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
