TOURISM. Renames the Tangipahoa Parish Tourist and Film Commission to the Tangipahoa Parish Tourist Commission. (8/1/12)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:4574(B)(30), 4574.1.1(A)(30), 4574.2(E), and 4574.6,
3 relative to the Tangipahoa Parish Tourist and Film Commission; to rename the
4 commission; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 33:4574(B)(30), 4574.1.1(A)(30), 4574.2(E), and 4574.6 are hereby
8 amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §4574. Tourist commissions; creation; purpose; directors; powers

10 * * *

11 B. Pursuant to Article VI, Sections 19 and 30 of the Constitution of
12 Louisiana, the following commissions and bureaus, hereafter collectively referred
13 to in this Chapter as "tourist commissions" or "commissions", are hereby specifically
14 created as special districts or commissions. Each such commission shall be a body
15 politic and corporate and a political subdivision of the state of Louisiana, composed
16 of the following territory:

1 commission and may sell, lease as lessor, transfer, and dispose of any property or
2 interest therein at any time acquired by it. The title to all such property shall be taken
3 in the name of the commission.

4 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 33:4574(F), the Tangipahoa Parish
5 Tourist ~~and Film~~ Commission shall be governed by a board of directors of eight
6 members appointed by the governing authority of the parish of Tangipahoa for terms
7 of three years.
