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TAX EXEMPTIONS. Authorizes assessors to allow claims and notifications concerning the homestead exemption to be made through regular mail or by electronic transmission through the Internet. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 47:1703.2, relative to the homestead exemption; to provide for the means of 3 transmitting certain claims and notifications concerning the homestead exemption; and to provide for related matters. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 47:1703.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §1703.2. Claim for homestead exemption 8 A. The assessor of any parish may authorize the homestead exemption 9 to be claimed by a taxpayer, and may also authorize notification to the assessor 10 that property upon which a homestead exemption has been claimed no longer 11 qualifies for the exemption to be made, by a taxpayer, through regular mail or by electronic transmission through the Internet on a form and in the manner 12 13 provided by the assessor. Such claim and notification shall be subject to the 14 same penalties for false statements relative to homestead exemptions as is provided by law. 15 B. Nothing in this Section shall be interpreted to prohibit an assessor 16 17 from requiring a personal appearance by a taxpayer or taxpayers or requiring

any other document or other evidence to be produced in order for the assessor
to make a proper determination of a homestead exemption claim.
Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the assessor of any parish to allow the homestead exemption to be claimed by a taxpayer, and to also allow notification to the assessor by a taxpayer that property upon which a homestead exemption has been claimed no longer qualifies for the exemption to be made by a taxpayer, through regular mail or by electronic transmission through the Internet on a form and in the manner provided by the assessor.
