AN ACT

To enact R.S. 33:9039(4), relative to special taxing districts; to remove sales tax authority
for plaza districts; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:9039(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§9039. Boards of commissioners of certain districts; **authority**

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, for a plaza district created in this

Part:

* * *

(4) The district shall not have the power to levy any additional sales tax.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
