SHERIFFS PEN/RELIEF FUND. Provides designations and terms of office for members of the board of trustees. (6/30/14)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2173(A)(1) and (6), relative to the Sheriffs' Pension and
3	Relief Fund; to provide relative to membership of the board of trustees; to specify
4	terms of office and designations; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 11:2173(A)(1) and (6) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
9	follows:
10	§2173. Board of trustees; executive counsel; educational requirements
11	A. The board of trustees shall consist of fourteen voting members as follows:
12	(1) One member, who shall be an active or retired sheriff, and shall be elected
13	by the members of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association as president, for a term of two
14	three years from the date of taking office. A vacancy shall be filled in the same
15	manner. Reelection shall be permissible.
16	* * *
17	(6) Annually In 2013, following the assumption of office of members set

forth above, one member, who shall be an active sheriff who is a participating member of the fund or a former sheriff who has retired and is a recipient of the fund, shall be elected by the members of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association. This member who shall be a voting member shall be designated as secretary-treasurer, with remuneration being limited to travel expenses and per diem, and whose duties shall consist of keeping the minutes of the meetings of the board and signing checks drawn on the fund. Beginning in 2014, the person so elected shall be designated as vice president. His term of office shall be one two years ending in 2015. In 2015, and every three years thereafter, the person so elected shall have a term of office of three years.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2014; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on June 30, 2014, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u>, relative to the Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund provides for a president of the board of trustees to serve a two-year term.

Present law provides for a secretary-treasurer to serve a one-year term.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the term "secretary-treasurer" to "vice president" and provides for the president and vice president to serve three-year terms.
