

SENATE BILL NO. 303

BY SENATORS AMEDEE AND MORRELL

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 42:1123(43), relative to the Code of Governmental Ethics; to provide for an  
3 exception to the prohibition of persons being employed by a political subdivision  
4 who have served on certain boards as designees; to provide for an effective date; and  
5 to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 42:1123(43) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1123. Exceptions

9 This Part shall not preclude:

10 \* \* \*

11 **(43) The employment of a person by a board that is created by law when**  
12 **the person has served as a member of the board as a designee, as authorized by**  
13 **law, of a mayor, but is not subject to confirmation nor confirmed by the council,**  
14 **of a municipality with a population of three hundred thousand or more**  
15 **according to the latest federal decennial census.**

16 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
17 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
18 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
19 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
20 effective on the day following such approval.
