AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 56:266(D)(1), relative to the Louisiana Fur Public Education and Marketing Fund; to provide for the trapping license fees; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 56:266(D)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§266. Louisiana Fur Public Education and Marketing Fund

* * *

D. Appropriations. (1) All revenues received by the state from license fees imposed on trappers as required in R.S. 56:251(A)(1) shall be credited to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. After a sufficient amount is allocated from that fund to pay all obligations secured by the full faith and credit of the state which become due and payable within any fiscal year, the state treasurer is authorized and directed to transfer annually the amount of twenty dollars for each ~~twenty-five dollar~~ resident trapping license sold and one hundred forty-five dollars for each ~~one hundred fifty dollar~~ nonresident **trapping** license sold, from revenues derived from the sale of said licenses, into a special fund designated as the Louisiana Fur Public Education and Marketing Fund.
