2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:699.5(A) and to repeal R.S. 56:699.8, relative to firearm and
3	hunter education requirement; to provide an exemption for hunters who are under the
4	direct supervision of a person who possesses a hunting license or proof of successful
5	completion of the firearm and hunter education course; to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 56:699.5(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§699.5. Firearm and hunter education requirement
9	A.(1) No person shall hunt with a firearm unless that person has first been
10	issued a certificate of satisfactory completion of a firearm and hunter education
11	course taught or approved by the department, or possesses a valid hunting license
12	issued by the department.
13	(2) However, a person under sixteen years of age may hunt without such
14	certificate if he is accompanied by and is under the direct supervision of a person
15	who is eighteen years of age or older and has a valid hunting license or proof of
16	successful completion of a hunter safety education course approved by the
17	department. For the purposes of this Subsection, "direct supervision" means that the
18	person being supervised shall be within a normal audible voice proximity and in
19	direct line of sight of the supervising adult at all times while hunting.
20	(3) However, a person who has not completed the firearm and hunter
21	education course required by Paragraph (1) of this Subsection may be issued a
22	valid hunting license by the department. Such license shall be issued with a
23	restriction that requires that person be accompanied by and under the direct

supervision of a person who is eighteen years of age or older and has a valid
hunting license or proof of successful completion of a hunter safety education
course approved by the department.

Section 2. R.S. 56:699.8 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
Section 3. This Act shall be known and may be cited as "The Louisiana Family
Hunting Law."
