# SENATE BILL NO. 40

#### BY SENATOR LONG

1	AN ACT
2	To repeal R.S. 13:997 and Act No. 492 of the 1962 Regular Session of the Legislature,
3	relative to the Natchitoches Parish Law Library Commission; to abolish such
4	commission; to transfer the property, assets, and revenues of the commission to the
5	Tenth Judicial District Court; and to provide for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 13:997 and Act No. 492 of the 1962 Regular Session of the
9	Legislature are hereby repealed in their entirety.
10	Section 2. All books, papers, records, money, actions, revenues, and other property
11	of every kind, movable and immovable, real and personal, heretofore possessed, controlled,
12	or used by the Natchitoches Parish Law Library Commission are hereby transferred to the
13	Tenth Judicial District Court upon the effective date of this Act.
14	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18	effective on the day following such approval.
