MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides relative to low speed autonomous motor vehicles. (8/1/22)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:378.4 relative to low speed autonomous motor vehicles; to provide for

3 regulatory exceptions for automated vehicles; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 32:378.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§378.4. Autonomous vehicle equipment requirements**

7 **A motor vehicle with autonomous technology that is designed to be**

8 **operated exclusively by an automated driving system for all trips shall not be**

9 **subject to motor vehicle equipment laws or equipment regulations of this state**

10 **that relate to or support motor vehicle operation by a human driver and are not**

11 **relevant for an automated driving system.**
