AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 36:359(L) and R.S. 38:3097.7 and to repeal Section 4 of Act No. 446 of the
3	2001 Regular Session of the Legislature and Section 5 of Act No. 49 of the 2003
4	Regular Session of the Legislature, relative to the Ground Water Management
5	Advisory Task Force; to provide for the membership of the task force; to provide
6	powers, duties, terms and conditions; to provide for the meeting requirements of the
7	task force; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 36:359(L) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§359. Transfer of agencies and functions to Department of Natural Resources
11	* * *
12	L. The Ground Water Management Advisory Task Force shall be
13	placed within the office of conservation, Department of Natural Resources, and
14	shall perform its powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities in the manner
15	provided by law.
16	Section 2. R.S. 38:3097.7 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
17	§3097.7. Ground Water Management Advisory Task Force
18	A. A comprehensive ground water management program must continue
19	to be developed and implemented. To that end, there is hereby created a
20	Ground Water Management Advisory Task Force with membership as follows:
21	(1) A person representing the office of the governor appointed by the
22	governor.
23	(2) The president of the Louisiana Senate or his designee.

12	B. The Ground Water Management Advisory Task Force shall assist the
13	commissioner of conservation and the Ground Water Resource Commission in
14	$\underline{continuing\ to\ develop\ a\ statewide\ ground\ water\ resource\ management\ program.}$
15	Such ground water management program shall include but not be limited to
16	evaluation of the state's ground water resources including current and
17	projected demands on the aquifers of the state; development of a water use
18	conservation program; study of alternatives to ground water use, such as
19	surface water to include treatment and transmission system, and reclaimed
20	water; incentives for conservation; use of alternative technologies; and
21	education and conservation programs. The plan should stress conservation as
22	$\underline{\text{the primary mechanism for the protection of the state's ground water resources.}}$
23	C.(1) Fifteen members of the task force shall constitute a quorum. A
24	quorum being present, the favorable vote of at least ten members of the task
25	force or a simple majority of the total membership present, whichever is
26	greater, shall be required for the commission to take action on any matter.
27	(2) The task force shall meet at least once per year, or more frequently
28	as necessary. The task force shall report to the commissioner and the
29	commission periodically on the activities and progress of the task force on
30	continuing to develop the comprehensive ground water management program.

Section 3. Section 4 of Act No. 446 of the 2001 Regular Session of the Legislature
and Section 5 of Act No. 49 of the 2003 Regular Session of the Legislature are hereby
repealed.
