2	To enact R.S. 56:110.1, relative to the Quality Deer Management Program; to create the
3	Quality Deer Management Program; to provide for the management of the program;
4	to provide for the powers and duties of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries; to
5	provide for eligibility requirements; to provide terms and conditions; and to provide
6	for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 56:110.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§110.1. Quality Deer Management Program
10	A. The department shall have authority over the Quality Deer
11	Management Program ("program"), and shall formulate additional guidelines
12	according to property-specific objectives, goals, and limitations.
13	B. The program shall be developed using a management philosophy that
14	encourages good stewardship and unites landowners, hunters, and managers in
15	a common goal of producing biologically and socially balanced deer herds
16	within existing environmental, social, and legal constraints. The program shall
17	include protocols for the protection of young bucks, including an adequate
18	harvest of female deer to maintain a healthy population in balance with existing
19	habitat conditions and landowner desires. The program shall also promote the
20	production of quality deer, quality habitat, and quality deer hunting
21	experiences.
22	C. The department shall use its resources to do the following:
23	(1) Instruct and train qualified personnel as to the policies and
24	procedures for administering the program.

SB NO. 483 ENROLLED 1 (2) Supply landowners, hunting clubs, and cooperating agencies with 2 pertinent brochures, handouts, and other information containing management 3 techniques and applications. 4 (3) Properly prepare and suggest wildlife management 5 recommendations. (4) Develop and maintain a close working relationship with other state 6 7 and federal agencies or non-governmental organizations that have similar or corresponding programs directly or indirectly affecting public and private land 8 9 development and management. 10 (5) Provide incentives to encourage landowners and hunting clubs to 11 participate in the program. 12 D. The program shall be voluntary, and landowners or hunting clubs who participate in the Quality Deer Management Assistance Program are 13 14 eligible to participate in this program.
