AN ACT

To amend and reenact Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 324(A)(3), relative to bail in criminal matters; to authorize the Twenty-Third Judicial District Court to alter the percentage amount of bail to be deposited; to authorize the collection of an administrative fee for processing such bond; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 324(A)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Art. 324. Cash deposits

A.(1) \* \* \*

(3)~~(a)~~ The court in the parishes of St. John the Baptist and St. Charles, by written rule, may alter the percentage amount of bail to be deposited with the officer authorized to accept the bond and authorize the officer to charge an administrative fee, not to exceed fifteen dollars, for processing the bond.
