AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 22:119(B), relative to policyholders' meetings and voting rights;
to provide with respect to written proxy votes conferred upon any other policyholder
or upon the board of directors of the insurer; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:119(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§119. Policyholders' meetings; voting rights

* * *

B. The right to vote by any policyholder may be conferred upon any other
policyholder **or upon the board of directors of the insurer** by a written proxy.

Any proxy may be revoked at any time by the policyholder, upon written notice to
the secretary of the insurer or the presiding officer at any meeting.

DIGEST

Morrell (SB 563)

Present law allows the right to vote by any policyholder to be conferred upon any other
policyholder by a written proxy.

Proposed law retains present law and permits the policyholder to confer the right to vote upon the board of directors of the insurer by a written proxy.

Effective August 1, 2014.
