8	Section 1. R.S. 4:149.5(B)(1) and 214(A)(4) are hereby amended and reenacted to

12	B.(1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the
13	commission shall adopt rules regulating account wagering and shall authorize
14	account wagering to be conducted by a licensee operating a pari-mutuel live horse
15	racing facility located in any municipality having a population in excess of four
16	hundred fifty thousand persons as of the 1990 federal decennial census the city of
17	<u>New Orleans</u> .

<u>Proposed law</u>, contained in Title 4 (Amusements and Sports) of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, legislates with regard to classifications of parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas according to population by enacting local bills to limit the application of laws based upon specific classifications to one or more parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas, by adjusting the population ranges affected by the 2010 census, and by repealing certain provisions based upon certain population classification ranges, as follows:
