SENATE BILL NO. 649

BY SENATOR HEBERT

COURTS. Provides that when multiparish judicial districts are divided, fund balances are distributed according to how much each parish contributes. (8/15/10)

1 AN ACT
2 To enact R.S. 13:478, relative to district courts; to provide for fund allocation for certain
3 divided judicial districts; and to provide for related matters.
4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5 Section 1. R.S. 13:478 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6 **§478. Fund allocation for divided multiparish judicial districts**
7 **Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, when a**
8 **multiparish judicial district is divided, the monies in any fund of the prior**
9 **district shall be apportioned between the remaining district and the new district**
10 **in proportion to the monies contributed from each parish into the fund in the**
11 **calendar year prior to division.**

DIGEST

Hebert (SB 649)

Proposed law provides that notwithstanding any present law provision of law to the contrary, when a multiparish judicial district is divided, the monies in any fund of the prior district shall be apportioned between the remaining district and the new district in proportion to the

monies contributed from each parish into the fund in the calendar year prior to division.

Effective August 15, 2010.
