

SENATE BILL NO. 652

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 47:9010(A)(7), relative to the Louisiana Lottery Corporation; to
3 provide for the content of the annual budget report submitted to the Joint Legislative
4 Committee on the Budget; to provide for the reporting of certain personnel
5 information; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 47:9010(A)(7) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8 §9010. Powers and obligations of corporation's president; residence in Louisiana;
9 ongoing study authorized

10 A. The president, as chief executive officer of the corporation, shall direct
11 and supervise all administrative and technical activities in accordance with the
12 provisions of this Subtitle and within the administrative regulations adopted by the
13 board. He shall:

14 * * *

15 (7) ~~Beginning on March 1, 1991, and not~~ **Not** later than thirty days before
16 the beginning of each ~~subsequent~~ regular session of the legislature, submit the
17 proposed annual budget of the corporation and projected net proceeds to the Joint
18 Legislative Committee on the Budget for review and approval. **In addition, the**
19 **proposed annual budget of the corporation shall include a personnel table**
20 **reporting information for each full-time and part-time permanent position, as**
21 **follows:**

22 **(a) The position title and the salary or wage for each position in the**
23 **existing operating budget for the current fiscal year, indicating whether each**
24 **position is filled or vacant as of the reporting date.**

25 **(b) The position title and the salary or wage requested for each position**
26 **for the next fiscal year.**

27 * * *

1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
2 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
3 2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
