SENATE BILL NO. 663

STATE AGENCIES. Prohibits state agencies from supporting certain events. (7/1/14)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 39:469.1, relative to tax exemptions, rebates, or economic development  
3 incentives for use associated with publicly-owned facilities; to prohibit financial  
4 support by state agencies for certain events; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 39:469.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 **§469.1. Prohibited events; publicly-owned facility**

8 **No state agency shall provide financial support of any kind to any event,**  
9 **activity, or enterprise sponsored by a nonpublic entity if any contract entered**  
10 **into for such event, activity, or enterprise operates to prevent the contracted**  
11 **person or entity from participating in any other type of activity conducted in**  
12 **any other type of facility owned or operated by the state, any political**  
13 **subdivision of the state, or any agency, board, commission, or instrumentality**  
14 **thereof.**

15 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014; if vetoed by the governor  
16 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective July 1, 2014,  
17 or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

DIGEST

Cortez (SB 663)

Proposed law prohibits a state agency from financially supporting an event that prohibits a contracted person or entity from participating in an activity in a state-owned facility.

Effective July 1, 2014.
