2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:1903(A)(2), (5), and (6) and 1922(G) and to enact R.S.
3	11:1903(A)(7), relative to the Parochial Employees' Retirement System; to provide
4	relative to eligibility to participate in the system; to provide for requirements and
5	limitations on such ability; to require a participating employer to extend benefits to
6	all employees; to prohibit participation by certain employees whose employment is
7	covered by another public system, plan, or fund; to specify that an employer with
8	employees eligible for another public system, plan, or fund shall not be eligible to
9	enter a participation agreement with this system; to provide for an effective date; and
10	to provide for related matters.
11	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
13	Section 1. R.S. 11:1903(A)(2), (5), and (6) and 1922(G) are hereby amended and
14	reenacted and R.S. 11:1903(A)(7) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
15	§1903. Admission of taxing districts; district indigent defender programs soil and
16	water conservation districts
17	A. Any taxing district of a parish that qualifies as an employer pursuant to
18	R.S. 11:1902(13) or any branch or section of a parish that qualifies as an employer
19	pursuant to R.S. 11:1902(13) including a hospital district, water district, library,
20	district indigent defender program in this state, or soil and water conservation district
21	in this state is hereby authorized to submit for approval by the board of trustees a
22	plan for extending the benefits of this Chapter to employees of such district. Each
23	such plan or any amendment thereof shall be approved by the board of trustees if it
24	finds that such plan, or such plan as amended, is in conformity with such
25	requirements as are provided in regulations of the board of trustees, except that no
26	such plan shall be approved unless:

2	(2)(a) it provides that all services which are performed in the employ of the
3	political subdivision or instrumentality, by any employees thereof, shall be covered
4	by the plan; <u>and</u>
5	(b) it extends benefits to all employees of the political subdivision or
6	instrumentality;
7	* * *
8	(5) it provides that the political subdivision or instrumentality will make such
9	reports, in such form and containing such information, as the board of trustees may
10	from time to time require and comply with such provisions as the board of trustees
11	may from time to time find necessary to assure the correctness and verification of
12	such reports; and
13	(6) it authorizes the system to terminate the plan in its entirety in the
14	discretion of the board of trustees if it finds that there has been a failure to comply
15	substantially with any provision contained in such plan, such termination to take
16	effect at the expiration of such notice and on such conditions as may be provided by
17	regulations of the board of trustees:; and
18	(7) none of the employees of the political subdivision or instrumentality
19	are eligible to participate in another Louisiana public retirement or pension
20	system, plan, or fund based on the employee's employment with the political
21	subdivision or instrumentality.

23	§1922. Persons not eligible for membership; persons becoming eligible for
24	membership in other systems
25	* * *
26	G. Any person who is ineligible for membership in the publicly funded
27	retirement system covered by his employment because of his failure to meet physical
28	requirements or qualifications shall not be eligible for membership in this system.
29	Section 2. Nothing in this Act shall affect agreements existing on or before the
30	effective date of this Act.

1	Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governo
2	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July
3	2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
