AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1963(C), relative to the Louisiana School of Math, Science, and the Arts; to remove statutory placement of the school within the Department of Education; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:1963(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1963. Louisiana School of Math, Science, and the Arts; creation; location; governance; relationship with educational boards and state superintendent

* * *

C. The school shall be ~~placed within the Department of Education, as provided in R.S. 36:801.1, and shall be~~ independent of the control of the state superintendent and of all local and state education boards except its board of directors.

Long (SB 89)

Present law requires that the Louisiana School of Math, Science and the Arts be placed within the Dept. of Education. Proposed law deletes the requirement.
