CRIMINAL RECORDS. Changes the name of the offender tracking system. (8/1/12)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:1228.6(6) and (7), relative to component systems of the
3 Integrated Criminal Justice Information System (ICJIS) operated by the Department
4 of Public Safety and Corrections; to change the name of certain component systems;
5 and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 15:1228.6(6) and (7) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8 follows:

9 §1228.6. Component systems

10 The component systems of the ICJIS shall include but are not limited to the
11 following systems:

13 (6) ~~The Corrections and Justice Unified Network (CAJUN)~~ **The Corrections**
14 **Offender Management System** operated by the Department of Public Safety and
15 Corrections.

DIGEST

Morrell (SB 96)

Present law provides that the component systems of the ICJIS shall include but are not limited to the Corrections and Justice Unified Network (CAJUN) operated by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.

Proposed law changes the name of the component system from the Corrections and Justice Unified Network (CAJUN) to the Corrections Offender Management System operated by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.

Present law provides that the component systems of the ICJIS shall include but are not limited to the Juvenile Information Records Management System (JIRMS) operated by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.

Proposed law changes the name of the component system from the Juvenile Information Records Management System (JIRMS) to the Juvenile Electronic Tracking System (JETS).

Effective August 1, 2012.
