A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request that the division of probation and parole, within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, reinstate and reopen the St. Bernard Parish Probation and Parole Office.

WHEREAS, the division of probation and parole is a significant part of law enforcement within St. Bernard Parish; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous that the division of probation and parole reinstate and reopen the St. Bernard Parish Probation and Parole Office in order to better serve and protect the citizens of St. Bernard Parish; and

WHEREAS, the St. Bernard Parish Council passed a resolution on May 4, 2010 requesting that the division of probation and parole consider the reinstatement of the St. Bernard Probation and Parole Office; and

WHEREAS, the legislature wishes to join in with and support the St. Bernard Parish Council in its request to have the division of probation and parole reinstate and reopen the St. Bernard Probation and Parole Office.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request that the division of probation and parole, within the Department of Corrections, reinstate and reopen the St. Bernard Probation and Parole Office.
