SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

TRAFFIC. Urges and requests DOTD to study truck traffic on LA 1019 between LA 16 and LA 64 in Livingston Parish.

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 To urge and request that the Department of Transportation and Development to study truck
3 traffic patterns on LA 1019 between LA 16 and LA 64 in Livingston Parish.
4 WHEREAS, trucks are traveling upon LA 1019 through a residential area as a
5 shortcut between LA 16 and LA 64 in Livingston Parish; and
6 WHEREAS, such trucks traveling upon LA 1019 raise concerns for the public safety
7 of residents who live along LA 1019; and
8 WHEREAS, a study of truck traffic patterns is needed to determine whether or not
9 truck traffic should be restricted on LA 1019.
10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
11 request that the Department of Transportation and Development study truck traffic patterns
12 on LA 1019 between LA 16 and LA 64 in Livingston Parish.
13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and
14 Development submit a written report of its findings, recommendations and actions taken, if
15 any, to the House and Senate committees on transportation, highways and public works no
16 later than March 1, 2013.
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
18 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
