A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To declare April 17, 2019, as 100 Black Women of Metropolitan Baton Rouge Day in

October 24, 1981, and the local chapter, the 100 Black Women of Metropolitan Baton

Rouge, on November 5, 2016; and

economic empowerment; and

WHEREAS, the local chapter will create, develop, and execute programs within its

service area of Baton Rouge and surrounding areas that promote its mission while

specifically targeting black women and girls; and

WHEREAS, the National Coalition of 100 Black Women and the 100 Black Women

of Metropolitan Baton Rouge have declared the seventeenth day of April 2019, as 100 Black

Women of Metropolitan Baton Rouge Day.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

declare April 17, 2019, as 100 Black Women of Metropolitan Baton Rouge Day in

Louisiana.
