A RESOLUTION

To designate Tuesday, May 8, 2012, as Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

WHEREAS, professional surveying is celebrating its one hundredth and second year of licensure, first issuing licenses numbered one, two, and three to J.B. Bice, C.P. Couvillion, and R.A. Crowson, respectively, in 1908; and

WHEREAS, in April 2011, the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors hosted their Fiftieth Annual Conference; and

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors are compelled to follow rules of professional conduct in order to safeguard life and health, to protect property, to promote the welfare of the public, and to establish and maintain a high standard of integrity in the performance of their professional duties; and

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors at all times recognize that their primary obligation is to protect the safety, health, property, and welfare of the public; and
