WHEREAS, FIRST alumni express a greater interest in going to college and are twice as likely to major in science or engineering as other students; and

WHEREAS, FIRST robotics competitions are designed to foster a love of science and engineering and inspire young peoples' interest and participation in science and technology; and

WHEREAS, a FIRST robotics competition is as close to real-world engineering as a student can get, combining the excitement of sport with the rigors of science and technology (the ultimate "Sport for the Mind"), with participants calling it "the hardest fun you'll ever have"; and

WHEREAS, these FIRST teams and their mentors deserve recognition and respect for their hard work, dedication, commitment, love of science and technology, and quest for excellence.
