SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 175

BY SENATOR CORTEZ

MOTOR VEHICLES. Urges the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission to review the licensing application process and make necessary changes to streamline the application process that will enhance efficiency while maintaining the integrity of each license granted by the commission.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission to review the application  
3 process for each type of license and make necessary changes to streamline the  
4 application process that will enhance efficiency while maintaining the integrity of  
5 each license granted by the commission.

6 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission (commission) is an executive  
7 branch agency and is composed of eighteen members; and

8 WHEREAS, the commission is vested with the powers necessary and proper to  
9 enable it to fully and effectively carry out its authority, is empowered to make and enforce  
10 all reasonable rules and regulations, and required to prescribe all forms necessary to  
11 accomplish its purpose; and

12 WHEREAS, the commission is responsible for licensing persons engaged in the  
13 motor vehicle industry and recreational products industry and shall provide each person  
14 applying for licensure an application form developed by the commission; and

15 WHEREAS, a person serving in more than one capacity or having more than one  
16 business location is required to obtain and hold a current license for each capacity and place  
17 of business; and

18 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission's application process needs

1 to be efficient and effective for all applicants, especially those needing multiple licenses, and  
2 must maintain the integrity of each license granted by the commission.

3 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana  
4 does hereby urge and request the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission to review the  
5 application process for each type of license and make necessary changes to streamline the  
6 process that will enhance efficiency and effectiveness while maintaining the integrity of each  
7 license granted by the commission.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission shall  
9 submit on or before February 1, 2015, to the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer  
10 Protection and International Affairs, a report that includes a summary of any administrative  
11 rule changes, a copy of any new forms prescribed by the commission, and if the review of  
12 the licensing application process necessitates legislative changes, a copy of suggested  
13 proposed language for legislation.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
15 Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission.
