SENATE. Requires a roll call vote to adopt a resolution introduced on the last day of a legislative session.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To amend and readopt Senate Rule No. 12.10(C) of the Rules of Order of the Senate and to  
3 adopt Senate Rule 12.10(D) of the Rules of Order of the Senate to require a roll call  
4 vote to adopt a resolution introduced on the last day of a legislative session.

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana that Senate Rule  
6 No. 12.10(C) of the Rules of Order of the Senate is amended and readopted and Senate Rule  
7 12.10(D) of the Rules of Order of the Senate is hereby adopted, to read as follows:

8 Rule 12.10. Vote required to pass legislative instruments

9 \* \* \*

10 C. ~~A~~ **Except as provided in Paragraph (D), a** resolution may be adopted by  
11 a majority of the members present and voting, without the necessity of a roll call  
12 vote.

13 **D. A resolution introduced on the last day of a legislative session may be**  
14 **adopted only by a majority of the members present and voting by roll call vote.**

## DIGEST

SR 5 Original

Present Senate Rule provides that no bill or concurrent resolution shall be adopted unless at least a majority of the members elected to the Senate vote in favor thereof.

Present Senate Rule provides that no joint resolution shall be adopted unless two-thirds of the members elected to the Senate vote in favor thereof.

Present Senate Rule provides that a resolution may be adopted by a majority of the members present and voting, without the necessity of a roll call vote.

Proposed Senate Rule provides that a resolution introduced on the last day of a legislative session may be adopted only by a majority of the members present and voting by roll call vote. Otherwise retains present Senate Rules.
