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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act changing the definition of countable-income for MassHealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws, in Section 12, is hereby amended by inserting the  
2 following:

3 An individual’s and the spouse’s net earned and unearned income less certain business  
4 expenses and standard income deductions is referred to as the countable-income amount. In  
5 determining gross monthly income, the MassHealth agency multiplies the average weekly  
6 income by 4.333 unless the income is monthly.
