An Act relative to school business administrators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 41 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

3 School business administrators shall be required to obtain or hold a master of business  
4 administration degree.
