An Act creating a scholarship fund to increase the number of medical providers who are knowledgeable in autism .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, there is

- 2 hereby established a scholarship fund to increase the number of medical providers who are
- 3 knowledgeable in autism. Individuals eligible for applying for the scholarship are students
- 4 attending the university of massachusetts medical school, state run/public nursing schools, and
- 5 schools of state run/public dentistry schools who are either studying issues related to autism
- 6 and/or plan to work with individuals with autism upon graduation. Three scholarships total will
- 7 be awarded annually; on to a student attending the university of massachusetts medical school,
- 8 one attending a state run/public nursing program, and one attending state run/public dentistry
- 9 school.
