An Act relative to the transportation of students.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 8A of Chapter 74 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “thereto”, in line 16, the  
3 following words; “ Students who must be transported to a regional vocational school from non-  
4 member districts will be reimbursed at the same rate as students from member districts attending  
5 a regional vocational school.”
