An Act Relative to a Commission on Advertisements

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There is hereby established a special commission to study the feasibility of permitting
2 private sector advertising on city and town school buses. The Commission shall study and
3 analyze whether private sector advertising on state websites is a practicable initiative to generate
4 revenue.

5 The Commission shall consist of 3 members of the Senate, 5 members of the House of
6 Representatives, and 3 persons to be appointed by the governor.

- 7 Said study shall include, but not be limited to, the issue of fair market compensation for use of
- 8 state property, the ability to screen advertisements and the authority of state agencies to sell
- 9 advertising space.
- 10 The Commission shall issue a report no later than 270 days after its first organizational meeting.
