Accompanying the third recommendation of the Office of the Inspector General (House, No. 8).
Public Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
2 Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting after subsection (4 7/8 D) the following new
3 subsection:-

4 (4 7/8 E) (a) No person receiving compensation or other remuneration from a retirement
5 board or from any person doing business with a retirement board shall be eligible to serve on a
6 retirement board; provided, however, that a person receiving a retirement benefit from a
7 retirement board shall be eligible to serve on the board providing said benefit and may accept the
8 statutory stipend for such service.

9 SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of section 19 of chapter 34B of the General Laws, as so
10 appearing, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:- No person
11 receiving compensation or other remuneration from a retirement board or from any person doing
12 business with a retirement board shall be eligible to serve on a retirement board; provided,
13 however, that a person receiving a retirement benefit from a retirement board shall be eligible to
14 serve on the board providing said benefit and may accept the statutory stipend for such service.
