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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**
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An Act relative to the definition of low and moderate income housing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 20 of chapter 40B of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the
3 following:— Low and moderate income housing shall also include mobile homes and group
4 homes, manufactured homes, in-law apartments and any first-time home buyers participating in
5 any state or federal assistance program.
