An Act relative to voting equipment

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 10, the words "registering and
- 3 canceling" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- and registering.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 105A of said chapter 54, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 5 striking out the eighth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:
- The counted and unused ballots shall be sealed in separate containers and labeled as
- 7 such. They shall be transmitted, in accordance with section 107, to the office of the city or town

- 8 clerk forthwith. The voting lists shall be sealed in separate envelopes and transmitted to the
- 9 office of the city or town clerk.
- SECTION 3. Section 107 of said chapter 54, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 11 striking the words "or container" in the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the
- 12 following words:-, container or containers.
- 13 SECTION 4. Said section 107 of said chapter 54, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 14 inserting, in line 16, after the word "or" the following word:- separate.
- 15 SECTION 5. Said section 107 of said chapter 54, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 16 striking out the sixth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- He shall
- 17 forthwith personally deliver to the city or town clerk or transmit to him, by the police officer or
- 18 constable in attendance at the election, the separate containing the ballots cast and the
- 19 ballots not cast, the voting lists, the ballot box, the ballot box seals and counting apparatus.
- 20 SECTION 6: This act shall take effect upon passage.
