## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An act regulating residential paving.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 142A of the general laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking the definition “residential contracting” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following definition:-  
4 “Residential Contracting”, the reconstruction, alteration, renovation, repair, modernization,  
5 conversion, improvement, removal, or demolition, or the construction of an addition to any pre-  
6 existing owner occupied building containing at least one but not more than four dwelling units,  
7 which building or portion thereof is used or designed to be used as a residence or dwelling unit,  
8 to structures which are adjacent to such residence or building or the application of any paving  
9 material on a ground surface of the property of such residence from or adjacent to an area  
10 accessible to the property from a public or private way.
