### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

#### An Act relative to early voting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after section 25A the following section:-
- 3 Section 25B. (a) Pursuant to a request, in person, by a qualified voter, as defined in section 1 of
- 4 chapter 51, the local election officers and registrars of every city or town shall allow any
- 5 qualified voter to cast a ballot for any biennial state election, special state election, primary,
- 6 special primary or any other election vote prior to an election day as set forth in this section;
- 7 including but not limited to any city or town election.
- 8 (b) Early voting shall begin in the seventh day preceding an election. The early voting period
- 9 shall end on the day preceding the election.
- 10 (c) For the purposes of early voting, a polling place shall include a city hall election office and a
- 11 town hall clerk's office and the registrars of each city or town shall identify and provide for

- 12 additional centrally-located, suitable and convenient early voting polling places within each city
- 13 or town for use during the early voting period. The designation of an early voting polling place
- 14 shall be made 30 days in advance of the election.
- 15 (d) The registrars for each city or town shall publish the location of the early voting polling place
- 16 as well as the applicable dates and hours. Said publication shall occur during the week prior to
- 17 the commencement of the early voting period. Notice of the dates and hours of early voting shall
- 18 be sent to every newspaper listed in the in the Directory of New England Newspapers and
- 19 Periodicals, located in such town or city. Notice of the dates and hours of early voting shall also
- 20 be conspicuously posted in the office of the city clerk or in the principal official bulletin board of
- 21 each city or town and any other public building deemed necessary.
- 22 (e) The state secretary shall provide a sufficient number of early voting ballots to the registrars of
- 23 each city or town for use during the early voting period. The ballots shall be delivered to the
- 24 registrars of each city or town 30 days in advance of the early voting.
- 25 (f) Early voting ballots shall be provided to each qualified voter who participates in early voting.
- 26 (g) Prior to the commencement of early voting, the registrars for each city or town shall prepare a
- 27 list for the early voting polling place, containing the names and residences of all persons
- 28 qualified to vote therein, as the same appear upon the annual register, and shall reasonably
- 29 transmit the same to the election officers at every polling place designated by the registrars.
- 30 (h) The presiding election officer at the early voting polling location shall cause to be placed on
- 31 the voting lists opposite the name of any qualified voter who participates in early voting the
- 32 letters¬"EV" designating an early voter.

- 33 (i)At the end of each day during the early voting period, the presiding election officer shall
- 34 separate, compile, and record early ballots cast at each polling location into the appropriate ward
- 35 and precinct. The resulting list of early voters shall be updated daily and saved electronically.
- 36 By 5:00 P.M. on the day
- 37 before election day, the list shall be forwarded to the appropriate ward and precinct location.
- 38 (j) Sections 24, 25, 25A, 65, 66, 72, 73, and 75 shall apply to polling places during early
- 39 elections.
- 40 (k) The ballot boxes for early voting shall be sealed and locked and maintained securely by the
- 41 election officers.
- 42 (1) The registrars for each city or town shall designate a location for the counting of early ballots.
- 43 The early voting ballots shall be opened at the close of all polling locations on election day. All
- 44 totals shall be added to the totals at the relevant wards and precincts.
