An Act permitting candidates to appoint poll watchers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Section 105 of Chapter 54, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the words “seal up the same” the following: -  
3 “with a zip tie that has a unique serial number”

4 Section 2. Section 107 of chapter 54, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby  
5 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new language:

6 Each candidate for public office may appoint one poll watcher to observe the sealing of the  
7 ballots after the polls have closed. Such supervision may not be precluded by any election  
8 officer. Upon completion of the sealing of the ballots, the Warden shall provide the serial  
9 number of the zip tie used to seal the ballots to any poll watcher upon request.
