*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 40 Section 21D of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 language in the fifth paragraph:  
3 after the word "dollars": ", except in the case of the desecration of natural landmarks as  
4 designated by the Department of Conservation in which case not exceeding one thousand  
5 dollars,"
