AN ACT LIMITING TERMINATION RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection 2 of section 10 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 50 and 51, the words "fails of
- 3 nomination or re-election, or ".
- 4 SECTION 2. Said paragraph (a) of said subsection (2) of said section 10 of said chapter 32, as so
- 5 appearing, is further amended, by striking out lines 73-77, and inserting in place thereof the following
- 6 words:- the following circumstances applies: (1) that the employee has failed of re-appointment, (2) that
- 7 the employee's office or position has been abolished, or (3) that the employee has been removed or
- 8 discharged from his position without moral turpitude on his part.
- 9 SECTION 3. Paragraph (b) of said subsection (2) of said section 10 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is
- 10 hereby amended by striking out in lines 79-81, the words "of nomination or re-election, or fails to
- 11 become a candidate for nomination, re-election, or election, or fails".
- SECTION 4. Paragraph (c) of said subsection (2) of said section 10 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is
 hereby amended by adding the following sentence.-
- 14 The provisions of this subsection (2) shall be unavailable to any member whose retirement is due to
- 15 failure of nomination or re-election, or failure to become a candidate for nomination, re-election or
- 16 election.
