### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
- 2 contrary, the dental enhancement fee for community health centers and hospital-licensed health
- 3 centers as specified in the January 1, 2018 version of the MassHealth Community Health Center
- 4 Manual, subchapter 6, as code D9450 shall be increased by no less than \$15 in fiscal year 2020.
