The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to radiological emergency response funds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 5K of Chapter 111 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:
- The licensee of each existing and proposed nuclear power plant in the Commonwealth,
- 4 shall fully fund offsite radiological emergency response expenses incurred by the
- 5 Commonwealth or a municipality post closure until all the reactor's spent fuel is removed from
- 6 the spent fuel pool and placed in dry casks. No monies from any Decommissioning Trust Fund
- 7 shall be used to satisfy this obligation.
